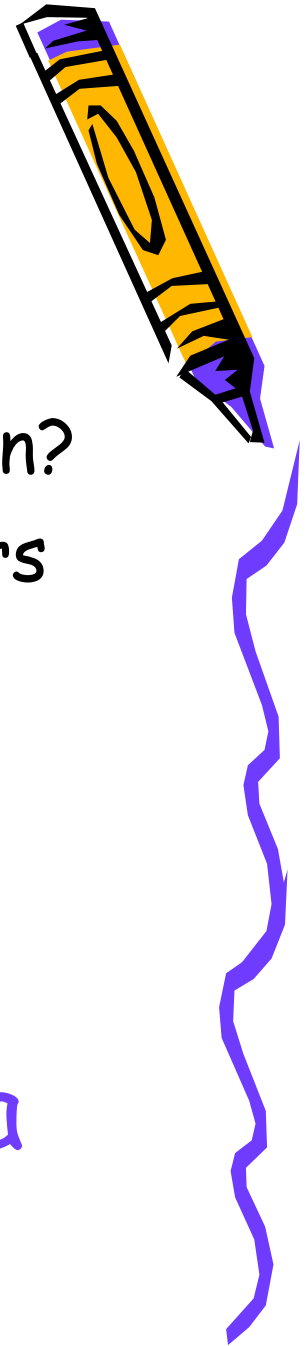


The Brownfields Patch Quilt



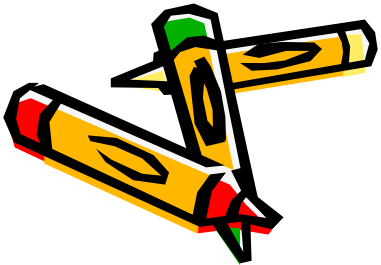
